

**Western Arizona Council of Governments (WACOG)
has been determined eligible as a tax credit charitable
organization. WACOG will provide you with a
certification letter when your donation is received.**

Q: What is the Arizona Tax Credit for Charitable Organizations?

A: You may claim a tax credit for voluntary cash contributions you make during a taxable year to a qualifying charitable organization such as WACOG.

Q: How much can I give to WACOG?

A: Married couples filing jointly can contribute up to \$800. Individual filers can donate up to \$400.

Q: How do I claim the credit?

A: You report the name of the qualifying charitable organization you donated as well as the dollar amount of your donation to the Department of Revenue. WACOG will provide you with a certification letter when your donation is received.

Q: What is the difference between a tax credit and a tax deduction?

A: A tax deduction is an expense that reduces taxable income a certain percentage. A tax credit, on the other hand, reduces your tax liability dollar-for-dollar.
